**Eneida O. Roldan, MD, MPH, MBA** is Associate Dean for International Affairs, Associate Professor of Pathology and Course Director for Professional Development, Professional Strand at the Florida International University Herbert Wertheim College of Medicine. In her role as Associate Dean for International Affairs, she is responsible for developing collaboration and innovative programs across the medical school with international partners and clinical affiliates. Prior to her current position she was the Assistant Dean for Student Affairs, Professional Development and Recruitment in addition to her current academic appointments at the same institution. She is founding faculty in the Professional Strand having developed the Foundations of Healthcare System course at the Herbert Wertheim College of Medicine. She is the immediate Past President and Chief Executive Officer of the Public Health Trust and Jackson Health System. During her tenure at Jackson Health System, she also served as Interim President and Chief Operating Office of Jackson Health System, and prior to that Senior Vice President, Associate Chief Medical Officer and Chief Administrative Officer of Jackson Memorial Hospital. Prior to her positions at Jackson, she was the President and Chief Executive Officer of Pan American Hospital. Under her leadership, Pan American Hospital evolved from Chapter 11 and was successfully sold and renamed Metropolitan Hospital where she remained Chief Executive Officer for the duration of transition of ownership. Prior to the aforementioned administrative positions, Dr. Roldan was President & Medical Director of her own Medical practice in Obesity & Clinical Research for 14 years.
